IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met

Este informe contiene información muy importante sobre su agua potable. Tradúzcalo o hable con alguien que lo entienda bien.

Our water system recently violated a drinking water requirement. Although this situation is not an emergency, as our customers you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. A routine monthly total coliform sample was collected on 4/2/23 and lab results were absent. The results were not submitted to the State as no Monitoring Schedule had been provided to the system. The water system had been designated INACTIVE since 2004 and was in the process of becoming an ACTIVE public water system status. When the sample was collected, all correct protocols were followed however the PWSID (Public Water System ID) was not included on the paperwork so the State did not receive a copy of the sample results. This resulted in a Tier 3 Violation.

On 5/2/23 the error was brought up to operations staff by CDPHE officials. On 5/9/23, a sample correction form to include the PWSID on the sample was submitted however the violations stood.

What does this mean? What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours. There was no added health risk as a result of this violation and no alternative water supplies need to be used.

What is being done?

 A sample correction form was submitted on 5/9/23 and this Tier 3 Violation Public Notification will be distributed to all customers.
