FINDINGS, ORDER AND DECREE

IN RE THE ORGANIZATION OF VALLEY AT WINTER PARK WATER DISTRICT. GRAND COUNTY, COLORADO

This matter coming before the Court upon the filing of the Petition for Issuance of Findings, Order and Decree and the Canvass Board's Certificate of Official Abstract of Votes Cast relating to an election held on September 21, 1999, in accordance with the Order for Organizational Election entered by this Court on July 22, 1999, at which election there were presented to the eligible electors the questions of the organization of Valley at Winter Park Water District ("District") and the election of Now this Court, having considered the Directors thereof. documentary evidence and being fully advised in the premises, does hereby FIND:

- That the questions of the organization of the District and the election of Directors thereof were duly submitted to the eligible electors at an election held at the time and place specified in the Order for Organizational Election.
- That the required Notice of Election was duly published in compliance with the Order of Organizational Election and in accordance with all statutory requirements.
- That the Canvass Board has duly certified its election 3. returns to this Court as required by law, which Certificate shows that all ballots were cast at the election by eligible electors, and the election results are as follows:

For the Organization of Valley at Winter Park Water District: Five (5) Against the Organization of Valley at Winter Park Water District:

That a majority of the votes cast at the election are in favor of the organization of the District.

- 7. That the election was held in accordance with the provisions of Articles 1 to 13, Title 1, C.R.S. and Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S., and all requirements of Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S., have been complied with, met, and performed in this proceeding for the organization of the District.
- 8. That the legal description of the boundaries of the District is set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference and is legally sufficient to give notice to all persons of the District's boundaries for all purposes relating to this organization and all other functions or activities of the District.

The Court being fully advised in this matter, it is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

- 9. That this Court has jurisdiction in all matters pertaining to this action as provided by law.
- 10. That the Canvass Board's Certificate of Official Abstract of Votes Cast filed herein is hereby approved and confirmed in all respects.
- 11. That the District has been, and is hereby declared to be duly organized and is hereby named, and shall be known as the Valley at Winter Park Water District.
- 12. That the District is located within Grand County, Colorado, and a description of the boundaries of the District and the territory to be included therein is attached hereto as

Exhibit A. Further, a map of the District, the Resolution of Approval of the District Service Plan adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, Colorado, and a copy of the approved Service Plan are all on file with this Court and are incorporated into this Order and Decree by this reference.

13. That the five electors of the District who were elected and are therefore designated to serve on the first Board of Directors of the District are as follows:

Terms to expire May 2000:

Clara I. Anema

Karen L. Taylor

Terms to expire May 2002:

Charles Anema Michael Taylor

Jerrie F. Eckelberger

14. That the members of the Board of Directors of the District shall qualify for office and organize such Board in the manner prescribed by law and shall file with the Clerk of this Court their Oaths of Office and individual, schedule, or blanket corporate surety bonds, at the expense of the District, in the amounts and form specified by law.

- 15. That within thirty days after the date hereof, the District shall transmit to, and cause to be recorded by, the Grand County Clerk and Recorder a certified copy of this Findings, Order and Decree. A copy of this Findings, Order and Decree and the District Service Plan shall also be filed with the Division of Local Government. A map of the District shall be filed with the Grand County Assessor and Division of Local Government.
- 16. That the District shall be a quasi-municipal corporation and a political subdivision of the State of Colorado with all powers of a water district as set forth in Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S.; and that the facilities, services, and financial arrangements of the District shall be implemented and conform, as far as practicable, to the District Service Plan and Resolution of Approval of the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, Colorado.
- 17. That the District shall have and exercise, through its duly elected Board of Directors and officers, all of the powers and authorities conferred upon water districts under and by virtue of the provisions of Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S., and all
